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*Note: The citation of the main primary sources here differs from that of Rosalind Kidd (1994 and 1997) when she carried out her research, even though I have used some of the same archival sources she has (e.g. on Deebing Creek.) When I first saw these files in 1999, they were held under different file numbers (see below). Future researchers need to be aware of such changes and check with the relevant repositories and libraries as to the current state of play.

These include letters and reports by Edward Fuller, and correspondence in 1918 not found in the Deebing Creek files cited above. The author searched these files and others when the archives were based at Dutton Park in the late 1970s.
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
